### ABSTRACT

This study aimed at knowing the Attitudes of Palestine students between violence the universities, to achieve this the researchers applied a questionnaire to a sample consisting of (365) students in all the universities in both Gaza and West Bank. The study aimed at knowing the attitudes of Palestinian students toward violence at their universities. And to achieve that, the researchers applied a questionnaire that consists of a scale to measure students' attitudes. However, the scale of the questionnaire applied to a sample of (365) students in all Palestinian universities in West Bank and Gaza Strip.

The results indicated that there is a high level of the student's attitude toward violence in the Palestinian universities, and there is a relationship between the level of violence and some variables such as, religion, age, university and location, So the researchers recommended that there must be
